1st / 2nd Last month we asked for prayer as we interviewed for a community support worker. We give thanks to God for answered prayers and for providing what is needed to employ two new workers. Evans, who trained with iServe Africa and was serving in Bethesda Baptist Church in Nairobi and Sam, from Crosspoint Bible Church, Nakuru, who we have known for several years and has led our holiday club lessons, have now joined the team. Please pray for them as they settle into the work and Njoro.

3rd / 4th Give thanks for the bible club last month. Nearly 160 children and parents attended on the closing day. Pray that the Holy Spirit would be at work in their hearts and they would come to personally know the saving grace of Jesus Christ.

5th / 6th Pray for Crosspoint Bible Church and those attending the two day missions seminar they are holding, starting 5th.

7th / 8th Last month we prayed for Gladys and her daughter who was unwell. Give thanks that her daughter is now back home but still needs prayer for a full recovery. Continue to pray for Gladys as she cares for her children.

9th / 10th All the boys who attend the Saturday Club had an increase in their school end of term exam results. One boy was top of his class. Give thanks that they are consistent in attendance and are trying their best in the lessons, this is a huge change for some. Pray that the teachers and their parents would encourage them and help them with the lessons they find difficult. Give thanks that they are always keen to come to club and share their news. Pray for the team as they continue to minister to them.

11th / 12th The funding for the APT project, making the chairs and standing frames for disabled children, finishes at the end of the year. Pray for an increase in support that would enable the project to continue next year.

13th / 14th We give thanks for God's work in the lives of the parents who come to the Parent Support Group and have shared how much the group has helped to improve relationships at home. Many parents that come have not had positive child/parent relationships themselves and have not learnt the valuable skills that help build good family relationships. Pray that they would come to know the love of God and reflect it in their own lives.

15th / 16th Pray for a young single mum who needs heart surgery. To proceed with the operation she must find 10 blood donors in Nairobi where the surgery will take place.

17th / 18th Give thanks for the weekly Bible Study and Sunday services. Pray for an increase in attendance and that the gospel would be clearly explained and impact the lives of those attending.

19th / 20th Several children from our Disability Support Groups have been unwell recently and admitted to hospital. Pray they would know God's healing and for God to give strength and comfort to the parents as they care for them. Pray also that the doctors and nurses would have the wisdom and knowledge to care for their complex needs.

21st / 22nd All glory to God for the impact the APT equipment given to children with disabilities is having. One girl who could not walk before having a standing frame is now taking steps. Give thanks for every mile stone, big or small, that these children reach and continue to pray that the devices would be beneficial to all children.
